For Our Unhoused Patients

Please review the process for applying for emergency housing in Calvert County. If available, a social worker will consult with you to follow-up and provide additional referrals if you are eligible.

If you become medically stable and are to be discharged prior to having housing established, you will be transported to a local warming center when there are freezing temperatures. Local warming centers include: Calvert County Detention Center, MD State Police Barracks (Prince Frederick location), Calvert County Library.

If the temperatures are above freezing you can reach Ryan Divine at Calvert County Health Dept, who will provide food, hygiene kits, tents, sleeping bags: 443.771.2321
